- Congiuntiviti







COVID COMPLICANZE NEUROLOGICHE

Viral spread via the transcribrial route from the olfactory epithelium along the olfactory nerve to the olfactory bulb within the central nervous system


- **Lechien et al:** 85,6% (n= 417) COVID-19 patients had olfactory dysfunction (OD)
- **Salmon et al:** 94% with sudden OD but no other nasal/respiratory symptoms od COVID 19 tested positive

COVID-19 may increase the risk of long-term health problems

Body systems and organs that can be affected :

- **Heart**
 - Damage to heart muscle, heart failure
- **Lungs**
 - Damage to lung tissue and restrictive lung failure
- **Brain and the nervous system**
 - Loss of sense of smell (anosmia)
 - Consequences of thrombo-embolic events such as pulmonary embolism, heart attack, stroke
 - Cognitive impairment (e.g. memory and concentration)
- **Mental health**
 - Anxiety, depression, post-traumatic stress disorder and sleep disturbance
- **Musculoskeletal and others**
 - Pain in joint and muscles
 - Fatigue

COVID-19 related risk factors for venous thromboembolism



Symptoms which may persist:

- **Fatigue**
- **Cough, congestion or shortness of breath**
- **Loss of taste or smell**
- **Headache, body aches**
- **Diarrhea, nausea**
- **Chest or abdominal pain**
- **Confusion**





